



Stratford Hall Grade 8-12 Supply List 2018 - 2019

Senior School students are expected to come to school prepared with supplies and will be supported in developing their own organizational system. Please note that all Senior School students will receive a student agenda, which we recommend for use to keep track of homework. Here is only a suggested list; you may have a better system that works for you, which is fine.

Suggested Supplies:

- One 1" binder for each subject (English, Humanities, Math, Science, Spanish and/or French, OEE, Fine Arts elective, Technology elective)
- One twin-pocket folder for Theatre (grade 8 only)
- One journal for creative writing (grade 8 only)
- Lined, hole-punched paper (*minimum* 1 package to start, replenish as required)
- Graph paper (1 package to start, replenish as required)
- One pack multi-coloured sticky notes (3" x 3")
- One pack index cards (3" x 5")
- Writing utensils (pencils, pens, highlighters, pencil crayons, erasers)
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- 30cm ruler
- 180° protractor (half-circle)
- Tissues (small packs)
- Calculator:
 - It is highly recommended that students etch their name, initials or distinguishing feature onto their calculator
 - Grade 9 students must have a minimum of a scientific calculator
 - Grade 10-12 students must have a Ti-Npire cx (non-CAS) graphing calculator, updated to the latest operating system. The non-CAS version has a white trim around the edge:
