

Stratford Hall Grade 6 Supply List

2018-2019



Grade 6 MYP students come to school prepared with their own supplies and will be supported in developing their own organizational system.

The links for each supply are not the exact supply required, but are examples of what students could bring.

We have found that when students bring large quantities of supplies to school, they often are put aside indefinitely. As such, the **quantity reflects the amount of each supply that should be kept at school**. We encourage students to keep extra supplies (i.e. pencils, paper) at home to bring in throughout the year as needed.

**All electronics and devices, whether belonging to the school or the student, must be treated according to Stratford Hall guidelines in terms of care and usage.

Laptops that students in past years have found **useful** included the following features:

- Lightweight
- 13"
- Long battery life
- Good WiFi connectivity
- Fast CPU
- Front and back camera

The following supplies were found to be **unhelpful**:

- large/bulky/heavy laptops
- Touchscreens
- iPads with attached/bluetooth keyboards
- Zippered binders
- Multiple binders
- Non-erasable pens

Personal phones, tablets, and iPods that are used for learning experiences in class follow the same essential agreement as laptops.
